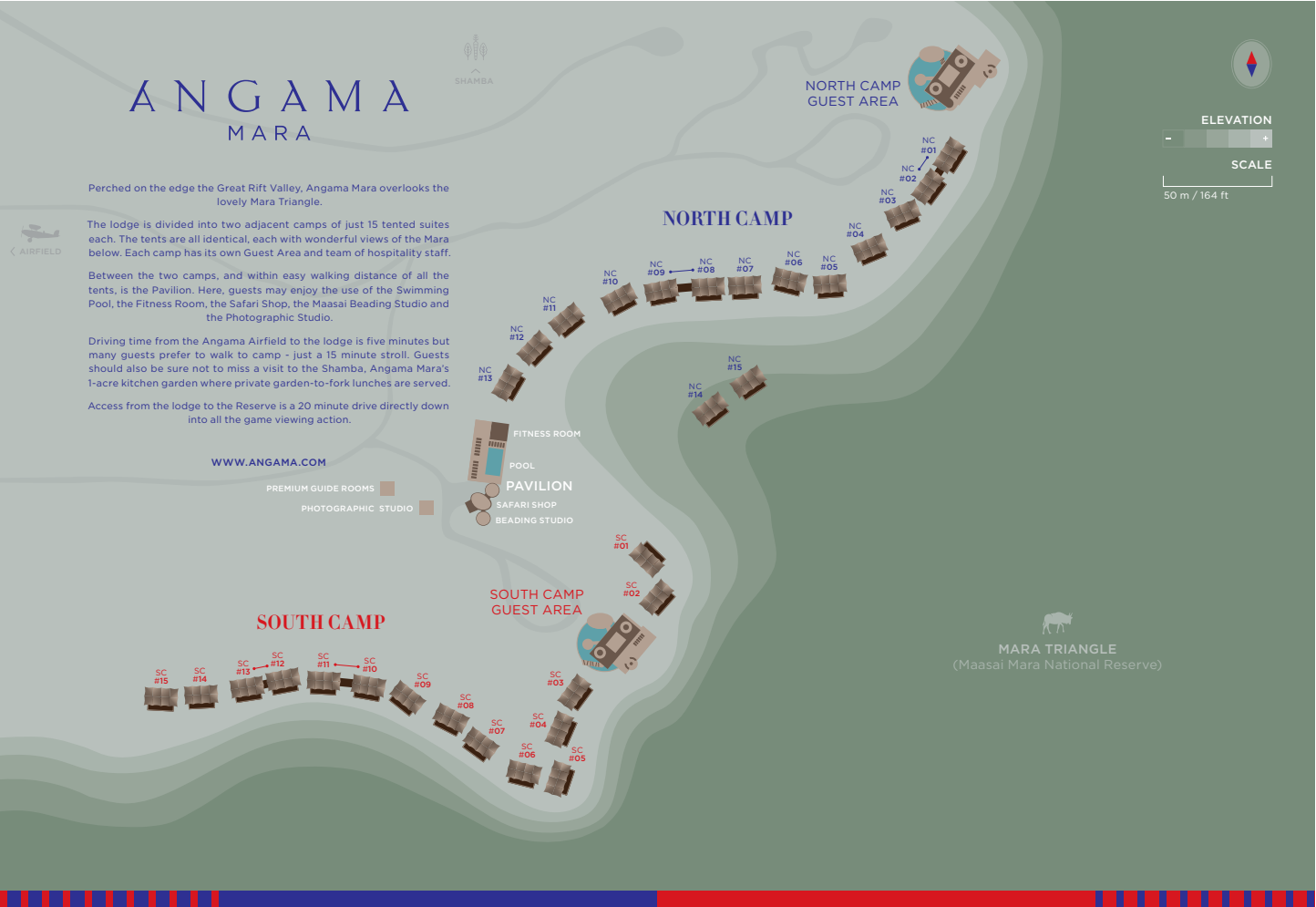


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## ALL YOU NEED TO KNOW:

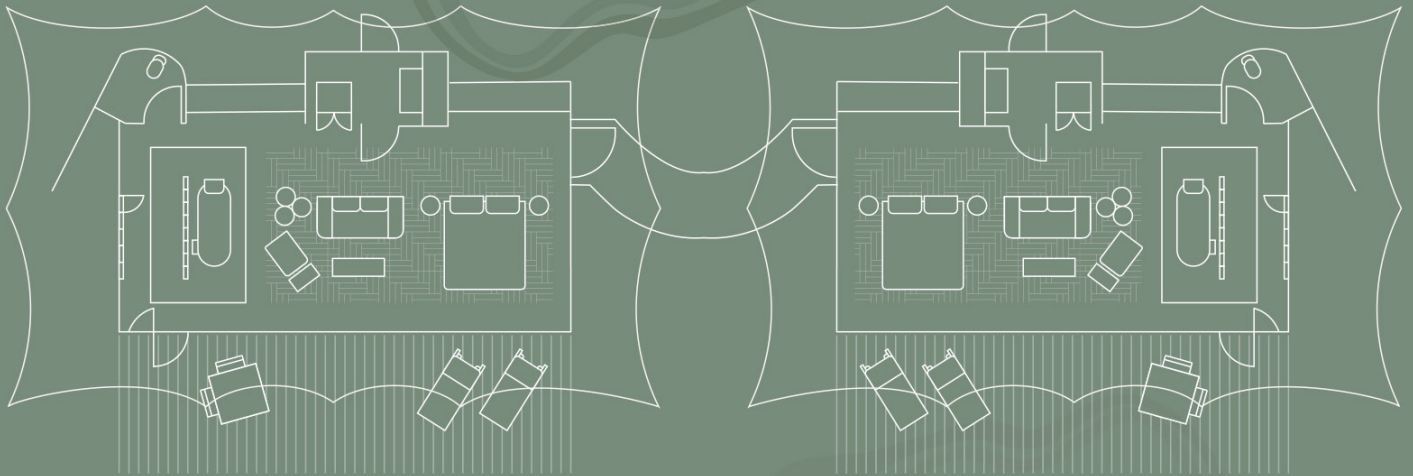
- The views stretch for miles. Perched upon an escarpment 300 metres above the plains of the Mara below, the name of the lodge was inspired by the Swahili word for 'suspended in mid-air' and no matter where in the lodge you are, you are guaranteed the best seat in the house
- The lodge is helmed by hands-on industry veteran, Nicky Fitzgerald, with more than 30 years of experience building and operating lodges across the continent
- Access is easy with Angama Mara's own airfield 5 minutes from the lodge after just a 45-minute scheduled flight from Nairobi's Wilson Airport
- The lodge is divided into two identical but completely separate camps, each with 15 tented suites
- The tented suites span over 100sqm, including the deck and feature 11m wide floor-to-ceiling glass frontage offering views from everywhere
- Many of the loveliest scenes from Out of Africa were filmed on the site of Angama Mara. As a nod to the film, the lodge offers intimate picnic for two on the crest of the Out of Africa kopje featured on the movie's poster completed with checked blankets, wicker picnic basket, champagne on ice and elegant picnic food
- Angama Mara's Photographic Studio is a workplace of creativity where full-time specialist photographic guides are on hand to provide tutorials, editing sessions and equipment hire
- The Shamba is a one-acre kitchen garden where guests can pick their own lunch to enjoy under the towering, shady Moth trees
- From its guides through to its camp manager, the majority of Angama Mara's staff are Maasai from local communities. This means that guests can learn more about local culture from those around them, as well as from the Maasai ladies in the Beading Studio

## HOW TO GET HERE:

Angama Mara is easily accessed by plane from Nairobi's Wilson Airport, with several scheduled daily flights that land at the lodge's private airfield, located just a few minute's drive away.

Another popular route is to connect via the Serengeti and cross the Tanzania/Kenya border west of the Mara. From the Serengeti, it's a short hop to Tarime, a quick road transfer across the border to the Migori airstrip in Kenya, and another short hop into the Mara.

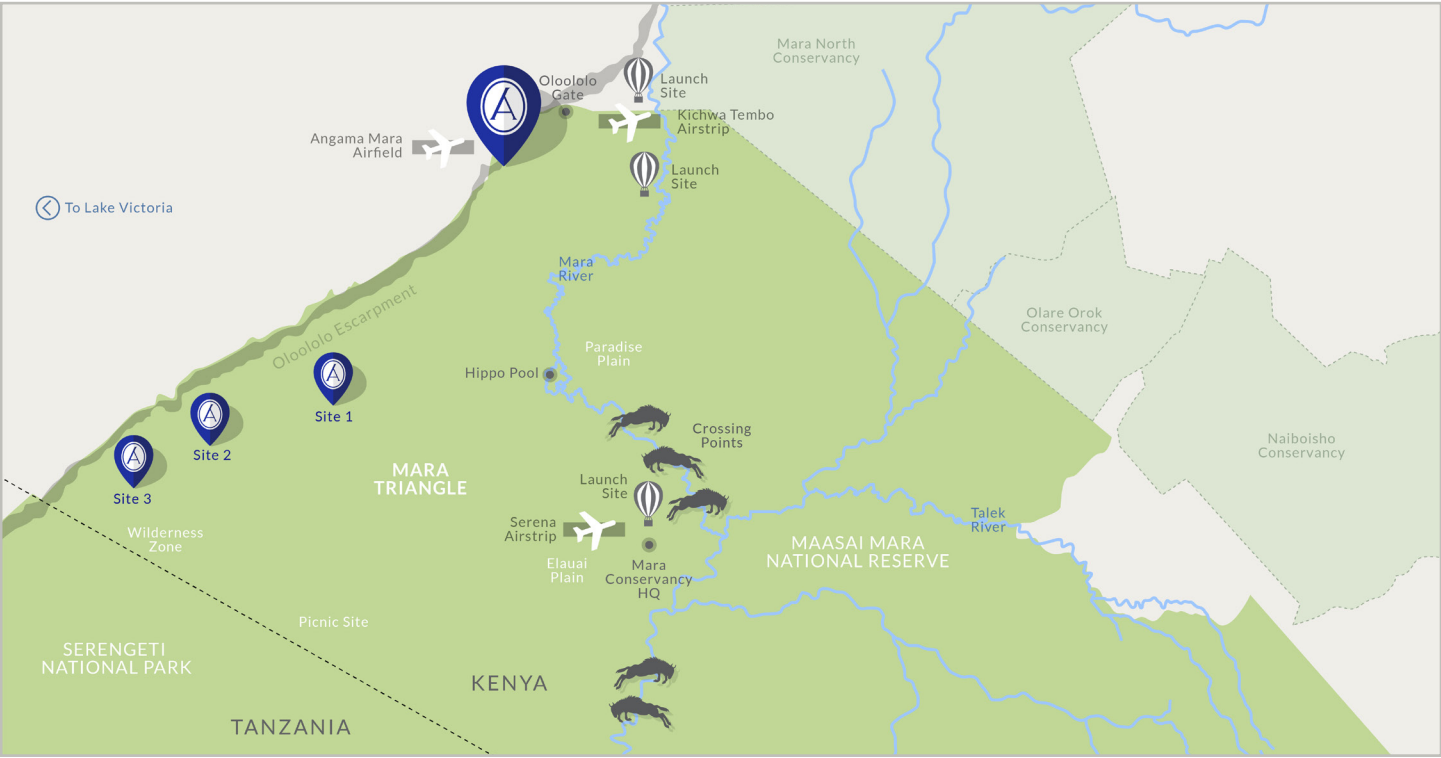
